#### **BULKY WASTE PROTOCAL**

## \*Acceptable Items Republic Will Pick-Up\*

- Refrigerators / Freezers (MUST have freon drained and tagged accordingly by certified technician)
- Hot Water Heaters (Must be drained)

Republic Services:

- Furniture (Must not exceed 50 lbs per piece)
- Grills (Must be emptied of ash or briquettes)
- Tree Limbs (Must be Bundled & Tied, no more than 3ft long, & not to exceed 50 lbs)
- Bagged Leaves
- Bagged Grass Trimmings
- Carpet (Must not exceed 50 lbs or measure longer the 3ft)

#### \* Items Republic Will Not Pick-Up at the Curb\*

## Construction Debris & Other Items Exceeding 50 lbs

Concrete . Large Rolls of Carpet . Tile . Dirt . Tree Limbs . Wood Paneling

If Republic is unable to service the bulky material that is placed at the curb, the driver will place an "Out of Compliance Tag" communicating the reason for non collection. Disposal options for items such as these are available and we will be happy to discuss those with you.

# **Heavy Trash Protocol**

Provided every other week (limit 2 items per pick up day)

Acceptable Items

-Household Appliances

(Refrigerators must have Freon drained and be tagged accordingly by certified technician)

- -Hot Water Heaters-must be drained
- -Furniture
- -Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes. No propane tanks.



# **Waste Acceptance Protocol**

#### Unacceptable Items

Wood Nails

Sheetrock or drywall

Windows

Insulation Stone Tree trunks Water softeners

Tires

Steel or cast iron building materials

Carpet

Tile

Paneling Doors

Masonry debris

Roofing material

Pool filters

Lawn mowers

Concrete

Dirt in large quantity

## Packing Peanut Protocol

Packing peanuts may not be offered loose, they must be bagged. Drivers will not clean up packing peanut spills.

# Yard Waste Protocol

- -All grass clippings, leaves, and tree trimmings will be contained in the poly cart except on heavy trash days. Grass clippings and leaves will be bagged and placed at the curb on heavy trash days.
- -Brush and Tree Trimmings cut in lengths not to exceed 4 feet, no greater than 2 inches in diameter, securely tied in bundles, not to exceed 45 lbs will be collected on heavy trash days as (1) item.

## Trash Container Protocol

- -Container size 96 gallons in volume
- -All waste must be contained in the Poly Cart
- -No free floating liquids in container
